HTML and CSS Development

This class will introduce students to designing and writing web pages without using a visual editor. Students will learn to write HTML and CSS code using a text editor through hands-on experiences and examples. If time permits, some javascript programing might be introduced. No assumptions are made about material students may have covered prior to enrolling for this class. A moderate to high amount of typing is required to complete many of the activities, primarily the later ones. It is expected that students will need to spend at least some time at home completing the programming exercises.

NOTE: This class is designed to run a full year (Fall & Spring semesters) so students can continue in the Spring with more advanced exercises.

Prerequisites: No prior programming required Students will need internet access a home to complete some assignments.
